

# **Application for Seasonal Tourist Business Designation**

This program is administered by PVSC on behalf of the Nova Scotia government.

#### Applications must be received by September 1st each year.

A new application must be submitted every year.

#### What is a Seasonal Tourist Business?

A seasonal tourist business is a restaurant, roofed accommodation or camping establishment that is closed at least four months in the taxation year.

#### Is my business eligible for the Seasonal Tourist Business Designation?

To be eligible for the reduced commercial tax rate, property owners must apply every year and demonstrate that the seasonally operated tourist business meets all the following criteria:

- 1. It is open during some part of the taxation year but closed for at least four months in the same taxation year (Note: the taxation year is from April 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup>).
- 2. It is occupied or used for the sole purpose of:
  - a. A restaurant (not including any part of the premises licensed under the *Liquor Control Act* as a cabaret, tavern, beverage room or lounge) \*;
  - A roofed accommodation licensed under the *Tourist Accommodation Registration Act* (not including any part of the premises licensed under the *Liquor Control Act* as a cabaret, tavern, beverage room or lounge) \*;
  - c. A camping establishment, as defined in the *Assessment Act* (not including any part of the premises licensed under the *Liquor Control Act* as a cabaret, tavern, beverage room or lounge).

\*Example: if a business is operated as a restaurant during the day and converts to a lounge or nightclub at any time, it is not eligible.

- 3. It is operated by the assessed property owner or their father, mother, brother, sister, son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, or spouse.
- 4. It is managed and at least 50% owned by the assessed property owner, or their relative, as listed above. In the case of a corporation, at least 50% of the voting shares must be held by the property owner or their relative, as listed above.

If the property on which you operate your seasonal tourist business contains more than one business, the property shall be identified by the kind of business that is the property's main business. The property will not be identified as containing a seasonal tourist business unless the main business is a seasonal tourist business and all the businesses on the premises are closed for at least four months in the taxation year.

## **Application for Seasonal Tourist Business Designation**

This program is administered by PVSC on behalf of the Nova Scotia government.

Businesses must apply for designation every year. A separate application must be completed for each seasonal tourist business. Completed forms must be returned to PVSC no later than **September 1**<sup>st</sup> of each year. PVSC does not have any jurisdiction to extend the deadline or accept late applications.

#### How do I know if I've been approved?

If your property is designated as a Seasonal Tourist Business, it will be noted as such on your assessment notice, which is sent in January of each year. If your application is denied, either because the criteria for designation were not met or because the annual application was received after the September 1<sup>st</sup> deadline, you will be contacted by PVSC.

#### Can I appeal?

Yes, you can appeal. For information on the appeal process, please go to www.pvsc.ca.

#### How do I complete the application form?

All sections of the application form must be completed to process your application. Please provide as accurate information as possible.

Your Assessment Account Number (AAN) is printed on your annual assessment notice, or it can be obtained by calling PVSC.
